



## First Night Box

Since you may not be able to unload everything all in one day, pack a "first-night-box" and keep it with you in the front of the car or truck. This could include toiletries, an extra outfit and other necessities.

## **Important Documents**

Keep all important documents such as tax information, birth certificates and passports with you while you are moving.

Keep a separate folder for moving-related documents, such as receipts, forms and final utility statements.

# **Moving Checklist**


Use a moving checklist to keep track of your to-do list. Mymovingchecklist.net is a perfect resource to help you organize, delegate and stay on top of your move.

### **Label Boxes**

Label each packed box and use different colors of tape to identify where each box belongs.

Keep all parts and pairs together when you are packing so that nothing has to be searched for later. Label everything so you know where it came from.

In addition to color-coding your boxes, number them so that you know which ones to unload and unpack first.

## **Remove all Obstructions**
